NCTR acknowledges the great work of our teacher residency programs impacting their communities and understand there are various effective pathways for aspiring teachers to enter the workforce and for school districts to retain teachers in the classroom. To that respect, we are collaborating with several affiliate organizations who are also positively impacting the educator preparation landscape to present the inaugural National Symposium for Educator Preparation, Policy, and Leadership.

In collaboration with <u>Deans for Impact</u>, <u>The Hunt Institute</u>, the <u>National Board for Professional Teaching Standards</u>, <u>Teacher-Powered Schools</u>, and the <u>American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education</u>, this national event will bring together teachers, university/college faculty, education deans, teacher leaders, school district personnel and superintendents, state licensure and certification professionals, education leaders, and state and federal policymakers.
